THIS COURT ORDERS that:


1. It is hereby declared that the defendant, David Hilderman, has breached section 52(3) of the *Professional Governance Act*, SBC 2018, c. 47.
2. Mr. Hilderman is permanently prohibited and enjoined from using the title “engineer” or other name, title, description or abbreviation of a name or title, or equivalent of a reserved title or other name or title in another language, in any manner that expresses or implies that Mr. Hilderman is a registrant of The Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of British Columbia or is authorized to practice the profession of engineering in British Columbia.

3. The Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of British Columbia is awarded costs in Scale B.
