NOTICE OF INQUIRY

**TAKE NOTICE** that a Panel of the Discipline Committee of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of British Columbia (the Association) will hold a hearing virtually via Zoom Video Conferencing hosted by Charest Reporting on October 7, 2020 at the hour of 9:30 a.m. for the purpose of taking evidence or otherwise causing an inquiry to be made with respect to the allegations herein pursuant to the *Engineers and Geoscientists Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, CHAPTER 116.

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that the allegations against you are that:

1. You failed to provide your entire file on an 8750 ft<sup>2</sup> single story combustible wood lumber storage building located at [REDACTED], South Slokan, BC (the Building) to the Investigation Committee of the Association, despite requests to do so, including but not limited to those made by the Association:
  - a. Investigator, by letter dated April 25, 2018;
  - b. Investigator, by letter dated May 31, 2018; and
  - c. Investigator, by letter dated June 22, 2018.
2. You failed to attend an interview with the Investigation Committee of the Association, despite requests to do so, including but not limited to those made by the Association.

- a. Investigator, by letter dated September 9, 2019, and sent to you via email;
  - b. Investigator, by phone call and voicemail message on September 17, 2019; and
  - c. Investigator, by letter dated September 19, 2019.
3. The conduct set out at paragraph 1 is contrary to s. 30(4)(a) of the *Act*, which provides that a member, licensee or certificate holder being investigated must provide the committee or subcommittee conducting the investigation with any information or records in the possession or control of the member, licensee or certificate holder that the committee or subcommittee may require.
  4. The conduct set out at paragraph 2 is contrary to s. 30(4)(c) of the *Act*, which provides that a member, licensee or certificate holder being investigated must appear, on request, before the committee or subcommittee.

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that you, Edward Nunn, P.Eng, have the right, at your own expense, to be represented by counsel at the inquiry by the Panel of the Discipline Committee and you or your counsel shall have the full right to cross-examine all witnesses called and to call evidence in defence and reply in answer to the allegations.

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that in the event of your non-attendance at the inquiry, the Panel of the Discipline Committee may, upon proof of service of this Notice of Inquiry upon you, proceed with the taking of evidence or otherwise ascertaining the facts concerning the allegations, despite your absence, and may make its findings on the facts and its decision without further notice to you.
