

# REGISTRATION POLICY

## CURRENCY OF EXPERIENCE

Version 1.0, January 30, 2026

Words and terms that are capitalized throughout this document have definitions that are specific to this set of policies. Please refer to these Defined Terms when reviewing this and other registration policy documents.

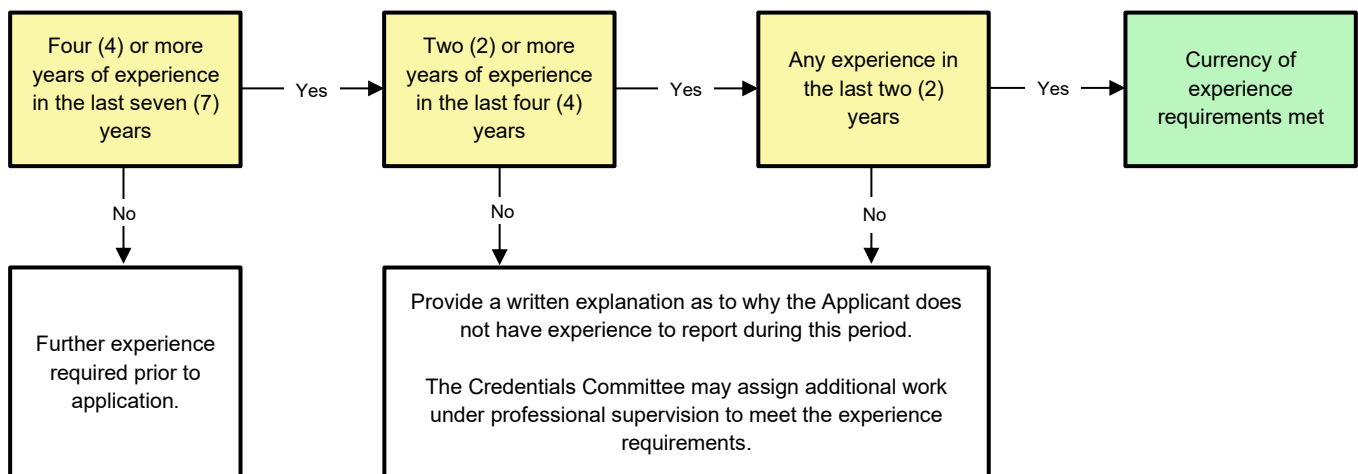
### PURPOSE

To outline the currency of experience requirement in the evaluation of an Applicant's experience pursuant to the Bylaws of Engineers and Geoscientists British Columbia (the Organization).

### POLICY

For experience to be valid for registration, the Applicant must show that their engineering or geoscience experience is relevant, current, and demonstrates familiarity with current Canadian codes, legislation, technical standards and regulations.

The following flow chart outlines the pathways for Applicants whose experience was not directly preceding their application. This includes experience in Canada or internationally.



Currency of experience is established at the time that the Applicant's competencies are submitted and validated will continue to be considered current throughout the application process even if the timeframe has lapsed.

The Credentials Committee retains the discretion to deny credit for experience gained early in the career of an Applicant whose work has since been outside their profession.

Applicants must meet all other standards for registration.

This policy is not intended to fetter the discretion of the Credentials Committee. The Credentials Committee has discretion to assess all available information and request additional information to evaluate the currency of an Applicant's experience.
