## FAQ:

### **Q: DO YOU READ THE BOOK BEFORE THE SCHEDULED MEETING?**

A: While there is no requirement to finish (or even start) the book prior to the meeting, during the meeting most members will have finished the book and we will be discussing it, so be prepared for spoilers if you haven't read it yet.

### **Q: HOW DO I PREPARE FOR THE MEETING?**

A: 1-2 weeks before the scheduled meeting, we will send you a list of discussion questions to consider. As a group, we will discuss and look into these themes, questions and topics further during the meeting.

### **Q: WHAT ARE THE UPCOMING BOOKS THAT WE WILL BE READING?**

A: All selected books are posted under "Upcoming Book."

### **Q: WHAT TYPE OF BOOKS DO YOU READ?**

A: We're open to anything that our members are interested in. Approximately every 6 months we spend part of a meeting discussing member suggestions and picking upcoming books.

### **Q: AM I ELIGIBLE TO JOIN?**

A: Open to all Engineers and Geoscientists BC members; there is no cost to join.

### **Q: WHERE DO I GET MY COPY OF THE BOOK?**

A: We send a link to the group to order the book online or get a copy at your local bookstore or library

### **Q: HOW OFTEN DO WE MEET AND FOR HOW LONG?**

A: Meeting dates vary depending on the availability of the facilitator. An updated schedule is posted on the Women in Engineering and Geoscience Division page. Cancellations and/or date changes will be notified to participants beforehand. Typically, the meeting runs weekday evenings from 6:30pm-8:00pm.

### **Q: ARE THERE ANY IN-PERSON MEETINGS?**

A: At the moment, sessions are currently hosted via conference call so that members across the province can discuss and connect on the book together. We also encourage members to host their own discussions before or after in order to dig deeper into the themes that resonate the most strongly for yourselves.
