It is a requirement for registration with the Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of British Columbia that transcript (academic marks) and degree confirmation be received directly from an applicant's institute of graduation.

Engineers and Geoscientists BC regulates and governs the professions of engineering and geoscience under the authority of the *Engineers and Geoscientists Act*.
