CANDIDATE VIDEO GUIDELINES

1. Candidate videos are open to all candidates running for the position of President and Vice President. Participation in the video component is optional.
2. Videos are limited to a maximum of 2 minutes.
3. Candidates are required to submit a written summary of their video content **by 5 PM on July 19, 2019** for review. Candidates will also have access to a teleprompter. Candidates who wish to use the teleprompter must submit a full script by **July 19, 2019**.
4. Candidates will be provided with a 45 minute time slot with the videographer to complete their video.
5. All videos will be reviewed by the Registrar prior to publishing.
6. As with all candidate statements, any content deemed by the Registrar to be inappropriate, defamatory, or which cannot be substantiated by the candidate may not be published, in the Registrar's sole discretion.
7. Video production will be hosted in the Lower Mainland. Travel reimbursement will be available for out of town candidates.
8. Two dates for video recording will be provided to candidates. If candidates are unable to attend either of the two dates provided, the candidate may create their own video and may receive full or partial reimbursement. Association branding standards will be applied by the association for videos created by the candidate. If a candidate decides to create their own video, a written summary of the video content must be submitted by the due date specified above.
9. The final version of the candidate's video will be provided to the candidate for review and acceptance. If acceptance is not provided by the specified time, the video will not be published as part of the election material.
10. No videos will be accepted after **August 12, 2019**.
