CO-13-02 <u>ROUNDTABLE SELF-INTRODUCTIONS OF COUNCIL AND STAFF</u>
The Chair led a roundtable of Council, staff and guest self-introductions.

CO-13-04 <u>INFORMATION ONLY REPORTS - OPEN</u>

- Past President's Report: report of Past President Holm regarding activities during the last weeks of his presidency from September 14, 2012.
- President's Remarks: President Isaacson advised of work ahead for the Council year, with particular attention to be paid to reviewing and updating policies as well as looking at the distinctions between policies and guidelines. He noted at their September Planning Session Council indicated attention will focus on engaging non-members to build the engineering and geosciences community. In addition, both at the Planning Session and at today's Annual General Meeting, interest was expressed regarding addressing gender diversity in the professions.
- APEGBC Activity Report: the APEGBC Activity Report is a new report in the Open session intended to cover items of interest to Council not otherwise placed on the agenda. Many of these topics will come forward as formal agenda items. Council reviewed the report with the following discussion highlights:
 - Item 1.1, Engineers Canada engages with Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC) re Internationally Trained Engineers: there is interest by CIC to establish a framework for fast tracking new immigrants with consideration of establishing out of country mechanisms to evaluate credentials required in Canada. Engineers Canada has commenced collaborative work on a proposal to offer a screening process.

- <u>Item 4.3, Organizational Quality Management (OQM)</u>: since the launch of the OQM program, over 20 organizations from government and consulting engineering companies have registered for the program. The first training session is planned for November. The initial response has exceeded expectations for this well received initiative.
- <u>Item 4.4, New APEGBC Directory will help public find engineering and geosciences service providers</u>: development of a new directory of members and licensees offering services on discrete scope projects is perceived as an excellent member engagement tool and service to the public.
- Schedule of Meetings to December 2014: distributed for information.
- Council Orientation Sessions, November 2 and November 29, 2012:
 all Councillors are welcome to attend these sessions.
