## Restriction of Practice Rights – Robin Spencer Chapman, P. Eng., Nanaimo, BC

A complaint was made to the Association relating to Mr. Chapman's structural engineering design and field reviews for a house in Nanaimo.

The matter was eventually referred to the Association's Investigation Committee. The Investigation Committee has accepted a Letter of Undertaking from Mr. Chapman, that in lieu of proceeding further with investigation of the complaint and potential disciplinary action, Mr. Chapman will restrict his practice to designing Part 4 elements within Part 9 buildings and all such designs will be independently reviewed in accordance with the Guideline for Independent Structural Reviews (even if they would be otherwise exempt from the requirement) by a structural engineer approved in writing by the Registrar.

This practice restriction will remain in effect until such time as Mr. Chapman can demonstrate that he has:

- 1. Provided a report from the approved reviewer that independent reviews of exempt structures are no longer necessary.
- 2. Undertaken and passed APEGBC approved continuing education courses related to wood frame design and construction and Part 4 structural design.
- 3. Read and confirmed in writing to the Registrar that he understands the requirements in APEGBC's Guidelines for Part 9 Structures.
- 4. Read and watched the webinars and confirmed in writing to the Registrar that he understands the requirements in APEGBC's Quality Management Guidelines; and
- 5. Successfully completed a general and technical Practice Review or the Organisational Quality Management program, including the on site audit.
