ON THE APPLICATION of the Plaintiff without a hearing and by consent;


THIS COURT ORDERS THAT:


- 1. The Defendant, Roy Johan Van Ryswyk, until such time as he becomes a registered member of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of British Columbia, is permanently prohibited and enjoined from:
  - a. engaging in the practice of professional engineering;
  - b. acting in any manner that leads any person to believe that he is authorized to fill the office of, or act as, a professional engineer; and
  - c. advertising or using, or permitting to be advertised or used, in any manner whatsoever, in connection with his name:


- (i) the title of professional engineer or its abbreviation "P.Eng."; and
  - (ii) any word, name, title, designation, descriptive term or statement implying, or calculated to lead any other person to believe, that he is a professional engineer or is ready or entitled to engage in the practice of professional engineering.
2. The Defendant, Roy Johan Van Ryswyk, will pay the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of British Columbia exemplary damages pursuant to section 27 of the *Engineers and Geoscientists Act*, RSBC 1996, c. 116 in the amount of \$10,000.
3. This order shall for all purposes be of the same force and effect as if judgment had been pronounced after a trial of this action on its merits and extinguishes all claims arising from the facts in the Notice of Civil Claim filed in this action, including but not limited to, claims for exemplary damages beyond those damages contained under paragraph 2 of this Order.
4. The parties will bear their own costs for this application.
