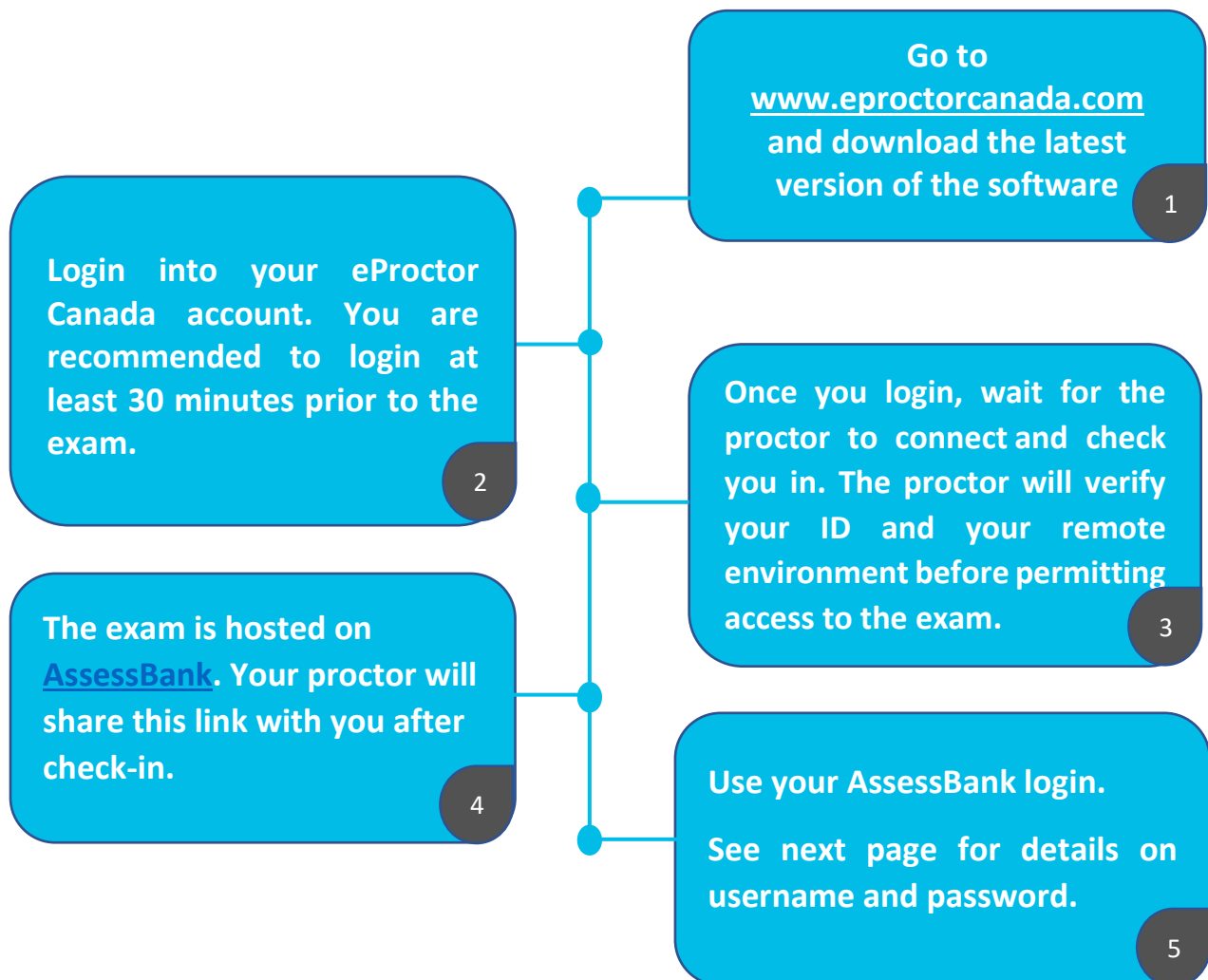


HOW TO ACCESS YOUR EXAM

The online examinations use two separate platforms to administer the exam:

- 1) [eProctor Canada](#) – for virtual proctoring and live monitoring.
- 2) [AssessBank](#) – for viewing your exam.

You should sign into your exam **30 minutes** prior to your scheduled time to ensure you have the proper set up for the check-in process and eProctor can assist with any technical issues that may arise.





AssessBank Username & Password

Username/Login: your email Address (registered with your regulator)

**Note: this may be different from your eProctor Canada username.*

Password: your password is preset using your regulator's acronym (lowercase) and your Date of Birth (mmddyyyy)

<u>Regulator</u>	<u>Password Format:</u>
	Regulator acronym (lowercase) + underscore (“_”) + Your Date of Birth (mmddyyyy) <u>8 digits</u> Example: August 9, 1991 will be 08091991
