THE PATHWAY TO PROFESSIONAL MEMBERSHIP



For undergraduate and master's engineering and earth science students.

Engineers-in-training (EITs) and geoscientists-in-training (GITs) have graduated from a post-secondary institution with the equivalent of a four-year, full-time bachelor's degree in applied science, engineering, earth science, science, or technology. They are working towards the required four years of work experience in order to obtain their professional designation.

Professional engineers (P.Eng.) and professional geoscientists (P.Geo.) have demonstrated that they meet all requirements for professional licensure. They are licensed to independently practise engineering or geoscience in British Columbia.
