2015 APEGBC Student Member Scholarship

The APEGBC Student Member Scholarships recognize undergraduate students whose volunteer, employment or personal actions over the past year have enhanced the image of the engineering or geoscience professions. The scholarships, valued at \$1,000 each, are awarded on the basis of a combination of factors including a student statement, a reference letter and advancement of the professions.

Deadline:

- Applications must be received by **5:00 pm on October 30, 2015.**

Eligibility:

- Undergraduate students attending BC post-secondary institutions, or BC residents attending post-secondary institutions in Canada outside of BC, who are registered as APEGBC Student Members
- You must be a full-time student in the current academic year (co-op students are considered full-time students and are eligible to apply)

Important Notes

- Incomplete or late applications will not be considered
- Only typed applications will be accepted. Use additional sheets if necessary
- Final selection will be completed in December 2015. All applicants will be notified of the results. Applications may be submitted by email, mail or fax
