APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Engineers and Geoscientists BC's Victoria Branch established two scholarships specifically to support third and fourth-year engineering students at the University of Victoria (UVic). Two scholarships, valued at \$2500 each, are awarded on the basis of a combination of factors, including academic achievement, community activities, and a student statement.

Your application form and all supporting documents must be submitted electronically to the Talbot Award Selection Committee by the application deadline.

DEADLINE

Applications are accepted until 11:59 PM on Friday, March 8, 2024

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must be enrolled in courses or in a co-op program for the current academic year.
- Applicants must be full-time UVic engineering students in the current academic year.
- Previously successful applicants who still qualify under the criteria above are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
- Only applications submitted using this application form will be accepted.

- a prominent member of your community if the above are not possible.

In 900 words or less, provide a statement that describes, in detail, your involvement in school activities, sports, community service, significant employment, or other enriching experiences.

SECTION E: STUDENT STATEMENT (30%)

A second statement gives your reasons for studying engineering. In 500 words or less, explain your views on how engineering impacts society. This is an important selection factor.
