This Issue

Homelessness. Addiction. Incarceration. Marginalization.

These problems represent a repeating complex and interconnected pattern that causes too much suffering in our community. A long term, innovative, and multi-faceted solution is needed.

Our Place has come up with a solution.

They have developed a Therapeutic Recovery Community. It's been modelled after an Italian community called San Patrignano that reports a 72% full-recovery rate for thousands residents who complete their program.

Using a "Community as Model" approach, this program will house men for up to two years, engendering healing and self-empowerment so that they can return to society and lead productive lives.

The Project

Our Place's Therapeutic Recovery Community has already opened at the old youth detention facility on Talbot Road in View Royal. They are currently ramping up to 50% capacity, which is the limit the facility can handle in its current state.

HeroWork wants to help get them to 100%!

This means transforming areas of this former jail into an environment of healing, community, and transformation.

FAQ's:

Can I get more involved?

Absolutely! For each shift we also have volunteer leaders who help coordinate the general volunteers. Just let us know that you'd like to lead a team.

When can I volunteer?

Most volunteer shifts are on the weekend (Sat or Sun), which is when the community comes together en masse. However, we also have weekday shifts for individuals and groups.

How does insurance work?

As a volunteer, WCB doesn't apply. However, HeroWork carries no fault Volunteer Insurance, including income replacement. Ask us for more details.

Can a company pay their employees?

If a company chooses, they can pay their employees to participate. Up to date WCB is required by the company as our volunteer insurance doesn't apply.
