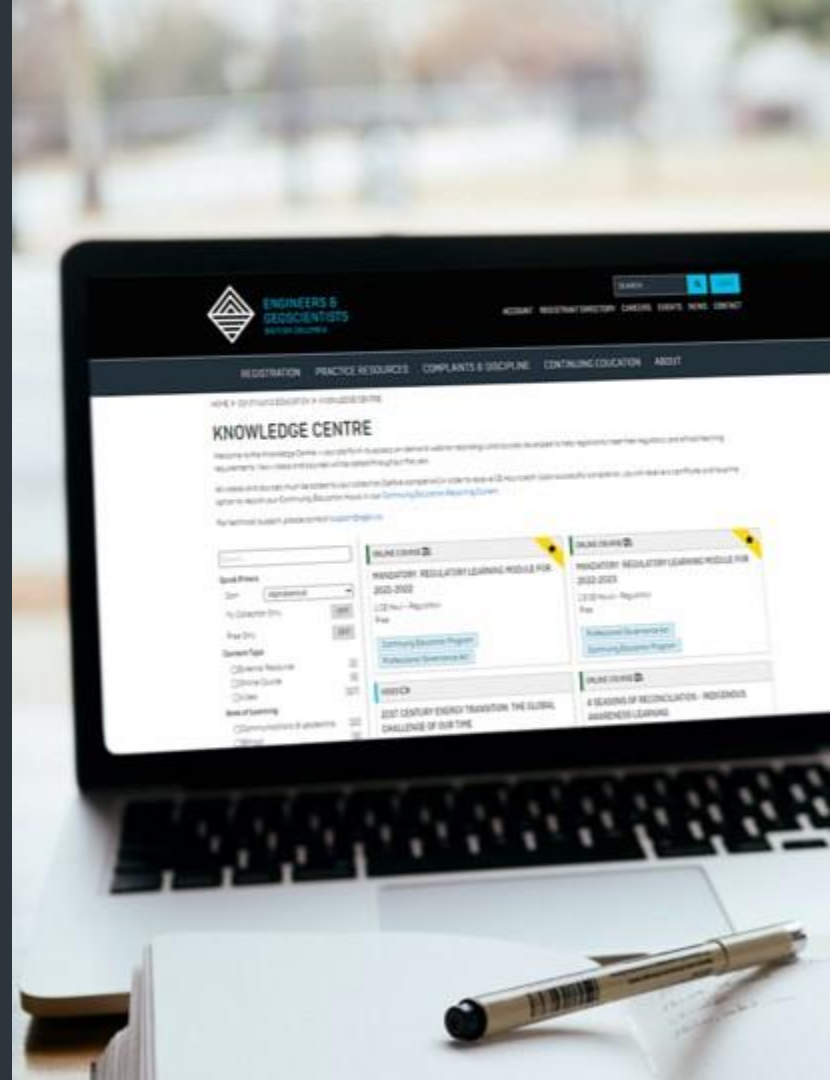
- View all your regulatory requirements in a single view including Continuing Education (CE) and Annual Reporting (AR)

Continuing Education Program

Requirements due by June 30, 2024:

1. Complete the 2023/24 Regulatory Learning Module on climate change
2. Record at least 1 CE hour of Ethical Learning
3. Complete a CE Plan and Practice Risk Assessment
4. Record at least 60 CE Hours of activities over the Three-Year Rolling Period.



Three-Year Rolling Period

Record at least 60 CE Hours of activities between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2024.

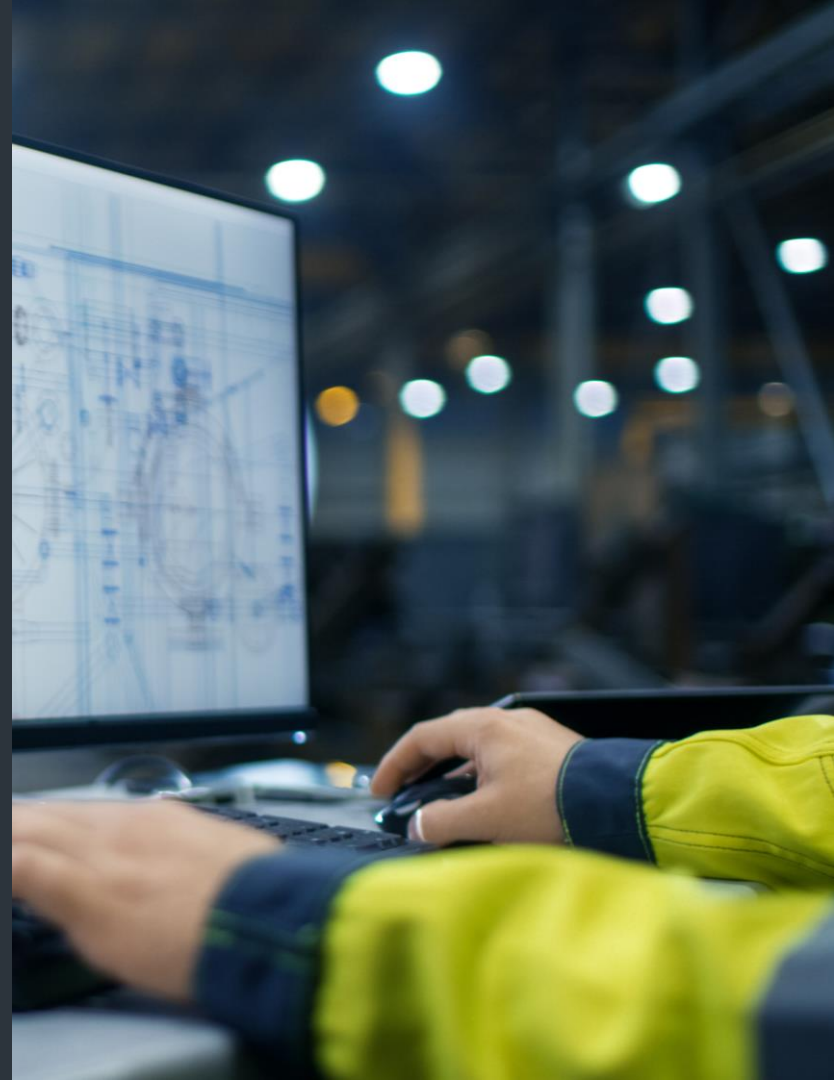
- Applicable for all professionals who were first licensed before January 1, 2022.
- Designated Structural Engineers must record an additional 60 CE Hours of Technical Learning directly related to their structural engineering practice.
- Check the Account Dashboard for your specific requirements.



Continuing Education Activities

CE activities do not have to be offered through Engineers and Geoscientists BC to be eligible and can include:

- self-directed study,
- volunteering,
- presentations,
- seminars, conferences, courses, and other activities.

Exemptions

- Registrants on a leave of absence (e.g., parental, medical, or compassionate care) from their organization or experiencing other extenuating circumstances may apply for an exemption
- Application deadline: June 30
